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5.2 ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY

We strive for a better environment by constantly evaluating what we do based on its environmental impact.

That is why we focus on

- challenge our own operations, customers, and suppliers to constantly improve the environmental impact of our products and processes.
- have a high awareness of environmental issues among all our employees, where we place great focus on reuse and minimize waste.
- keep us updated on new research findings as well as legal and other binding requirements on the organization, and to comply with these.
- maintain our voluntary environmental permit with the County Administrative Board.
- manage and streamline our energy use with a focus also on reducing the need for fossil fuels.
- continuously improve our choice of chemicals and prevent pollution to air and water, which is especially important considering our proximity to Lake Åsunden and River Ätran



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PURPOSE

This routine aims to describe the basis for the company's responsibility for the external environment.

SCOPE

The environmental policy covers all activities that the company conducts and must also be governing in contacts with customers, suppliers and other stakeholders.

ROUTINE

5.2.1 DECLARATION TO THE ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY

The external environment is a crucial issue for the business. Consideration for the environment must therefore permeate every part of the business and be taken into account in all decisions.

- Operations must be conducted in such a way that pollution to the environment is prevented.
- Constantly improve the business operation and its environmental performance.
- Special focus on limiting the use of chemicals.
- Reduce the amount of waste generated from the business and prioritize reuse.
- Reduce the use of energy and achieve the lowest possible energy consumption and, if possible, use renewable energy sources.
- Prevent pollution to air and water.
- Measure, follow up and reduce greenhouse gas emissions according to scope 1 and scope 2 in the international GHG protocol.
- Comply with current environmental legislation and other applicable binding requirements in the environmental area.

Environmental issues must be handled in a systematic way where we must **train, practice and motivate employees** to perform their tasks in a way that is responsible for the environment.

Precomp shall challenge its own operations, customers and suppliers by following developments and, when deemed appropriate, proposing new manufacturing processes or other changes, in order to minimize the environmental impact of our products and processes in an overall life cycle perspective.

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5.2.2 DISTRIBUTION OF ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY

The environmental policy must be known to all employees and available to the public. Suppliers and contractors are notified of the environmental policy in connection with the purchase of a service

5.2.3 REVIEW AND POSSIBLE CHANGE OF ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY

At management review, the need to possibly revise the environmental policy must be taken into account. In doing so, consideration shall be given to, among other things:

- Changed processes, products and services
- Changed approach and new knowledge
- Changed market situation, including changes in stakeholders
- That the policy should constitute a framework for current environmental goals
- Compliance with legal and other binding requirements
- The commitment to prevent pollution
- The commitment to constantly improve the environmental management system to achieve better environmental performance

RESPONSIBILITY

The CEO is responsible for ensuring that the routine is complied with, including that the necessary and sufficient resources are made available and maintained (finance, personnel, time, competence, equipment).
